Dispatches from Cell 92: Bonhoeffer on Faith and Resistance



Some call him a martyr. Others, a spy and assassin. But before his arrest and execution by the Nazis in 1945, Dietrich Bonhoeffer was a pastor and theologian whose writings on Christianity have become more relevant today than ever. In this six-part series, we'll explore Bonhoeffer's thoughts on grace, faith, responsibility, and resistance for clues about how we might live out our faith in ways that make a difference in today's world. The series will include an all-church book study and documentary film discussion.

Bonhoeffer All-Church Book Study

This seven session class is designed to accompany our sermon series, *Dispatches from Cell 92: Bonhoeffer on Faith and Resistance*. Each week, participants will explore sections of Dietrich Bonhoeffer's book, *The Cost of Discipleship*, that align with the sermon theme for that week.
